

Juice Carton Bird Feeder



This is an easy project you can do with your family or friends using items around your house. Reuse an empty juice carton and create a unique feeder for your backyard friends.

What you'll need:

- Clean, empty juice or milk carton- quart size or larger
- Wire, twine, or string
- Scissors
- Safety goggles
- Bird seed

Step 1:

Carefully cut a square-shape out of the carton, being sure to wear safety goggles. This takes a little bit of patience, so ask an adult to help you. You will be cutting the entire front panel off, and no more than half of each side panel. Cutting off too much of the sides may make weaken the carton.

Step 2:

Punch a hole in the top of the carton using a paper puncher or a pair of scissors.

Step 3:

Loop a piece of wire, twine or string through the hole.

Step 4:

Fill the carton with bird seed. You're ready to feed the birds!
