Milk Jug Bird Feeder



This is an easy project you can do with your family or friends using items around your house. Reuse an empty juice carton and create a unique feeder for your feathered friends.

What you'll need:

- Clean, 1-gallon plastic jug with the lid on
- 1 dowel or twig
- Scissors
- · Bird seed

Step 1:

There should be several round indentations on the sides of the jug. Cut two holes in the sides of the jug. Using a pair of scissors, cut two of the circles out. Be sure to wear safety goggles when doing this. This takes a little bit of patience, so ask an adult to help you.

Step 2:

Using a pair of scissors, carefully punch or cut out two small holes the approximate diameter of the dowel or twig) at the bottom of each side of the jug.

Step 3:

Slide the dowel through the two small holes. This is the perch for your birdfeeder.

Fill the carton with bird seed. You're ready to feed the birds!
