January 2024

February 2024

- If I am looking for a new home, I will look for a WaterSense labeled model that is more water-efficient.
- I will upgrade the look of my bathroom and downgrade my water use with new WaterSense labeled fixtures.



March 2024

- For Fix a Leak Week, I will check my water meter before and after a two-hour period to see if my home has leaks.
- I will use the Fix a Leak Week checklist to chase down leaks in my home.
